# Suspected of being a thief, Dalit man lynched; 11 held

THE NAVHAR police have arrested two more accused for the alleged murder of a 30-year-old sanitary worker in Bhandara who was lynched at his workplace earlier this month on suspicion of being a thief. In all, eleven people have been arrested and the police added sections of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, on Wednesday as the deceased was from the Dalit community.

The incident took place on May 7 when the deceased Krishna Dusamad, 30, a sani-

tary worker, was at his workplace at Nagmani Jewellers, Ushakiran building, in Bhandara (east). Suspecting him to be a thief, the shop owner, Chandicharan Bin, 33, and ten other persons working there allegedly beat up Krishna with bare hands, bat, wooden plank, and iron rod.

Krishna's father Palaram Dusamad, 64, also a sanitary worker, said on that day, he and his wife Birmatidevi, 60, were working in a building that also houses a hospital when they saw an injured man being rushed there in a car around 12.30 pm. Then they learnt the man was their son.

There were allegedly no doctors at the hospital so the injured

# Rane's Juhu bungalow: Minister may face action due to CRZ violation

UNION MINISTER Narayan Rane will now face trouble from the suburban collector for violation of coastal regulation zone (CRZ) notification of the environment protection act over his bungalow facing Juhu beach.

The Maharashtra Coastal Zone Management Authority

(CMZMA) discussed the complaints on May 4 and the minutes were put on the website.

The CMZMA noted that the Union Ministry of Environment and Forests had granted CRZ clearance on June 11, 2007, for construction of bungalow, but one of the conditions was that said construction will now issue a notice to Rane. The CMZMA this year, the BMC stated that if the unauthorised construction is taken into account, the entire FSI utilisation comes to 2.125.

The CMZMA has decided to forward the BMC reports and correspondence along with the copy of the ministry clearance of 2007 to District Coastal Zone Monitoring Committee for further action. The district collector will now issue a notice to Rane and seek an explanation.

# 3 officers held in Angadia extortion case released on bail

NEARLY THREE months after they were arrested from the Mumbai Police in connection with the Angadia extortion case, three police officers have been released on bail.

The three, identified as inspector Om Vyasare, APT Ninin Kadam, and PSI Saman Jamdade were arrested by the police on February 19 following an FIR against them, and were released this Monday. Two other accused in the case are currently behind bars while suspended DCP Saubrah Tripathi continues to elude the Mumbai Police crime branch.

An official said the crime branch had filed a chargesheet against the three accused last month. "Since the chargesheet was filed and the victims failed to identify the trio in the Test Identification Parade, they were granted bail by the magistrate court," an officer said. The trio will have to appear before the LT Marg police station every week as per the condition set by the court.

Currently, the domestic help at Tripathi's parents' residence and Tripathi's brother-in-law, who were arrested by the crime branch, are still behind bars. "We will be filing a chargesheet against them as well in the next few days," the officer added.

Meanwhile, the Mumbai Police may issue a Look Out Circular against Tripathi in order to ensure that if he tries to leave the country, the police will be alerted about it. The Mumbai Police had registered an FIR in the case in February after an enquiry revealed that Tripathi had sought Rs 10 lakh per month from Angadias. It emerged that three officers from the LT Marg police had threatened the Angadias and collected money from them.

# One booked for taking MP Navneet Rana's photos during her MRI scan

THE BANDRA Police on Wednesday registered an FIR against an unknown person who clicked photographs of MP Navneet Rana while she was in the MRI scan room for a test on May 6, and circulated it on social media. The FIR has been registered under Sections 448 (respassing) and 336 (act done rashly or negligently endangering lives) of the IPC.

The complainant, Amit Gaud, is a security supervisor with the Lilavati Hospital. The incident took place around 10pm on May

6 when Rana was sent to the radiology department's MRI division. Her husband Ravi Rana, his security guard, and an unknown person were accompanying her then. "The unknown person clicked her photographs while she was lying on the MRI machine. He further gave the photos to the media and made them viral on social media. It's against the rules to take any kind of electronic materials or metals in the MRI room. A board stating 'no videography, no photography' is also placed outside the room," the complainant said.

He said while the accused did not have the permission to commit the act, he has been captured on hospital's CCTV camera and the footage has been handed over to police.

Only this Monday, former Mumbai mayor Kishori Pedekar and Shiv Sena MLC Manisha Kayande visited the hospital and questioned the management on how Rana's pictures could be shot and circulated on social media.

Rana was admitted to the hospital after her discharge from Byculla jail last week, following her arrest for threatening to re-cite Hanuman chalisa at Matoshri, the residence of Maharashtra Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray in Bandra (East).

# Non-cognizable complaint lodged over threat to Raj Thackeray on loudspeaker row

ANON-COGNIZABLE complaint was registered on Wednesday against an unidentified person for sending a threat letter to MNS leader Bala Nandgaonkar where the sender threatened to kill him and MNS chief Raj Thackeray because of their ultimatum given to mosques over removal of loudspeaker.

"A non-cognizable complaint has been registered under Section 507 (criminal intimidation) by anonymous communication) of the IPC," said Anand Mulay, Senior Inspector of Kalachowki police station.

Speaking to media persons on Wednesday, Nandgaonkar, a three-time MLA and a former state minister, said, "I met Home Minister Dilip Walse Patil at his residence today and he promised that action will be taken. Yesterday, I met Thackeray saheb and showed him the letter. Later that day, I also met Mumbai Police Commissioner Sanjay Pandey and gave him the letter. The letter has been written in Hindi and contains some Urdu words. It came by post to my office."

Nandgaonkar added, "It stated that we should stop our protest against the loudspeakers and azaan or they will kill me and Raj Thackeray saheb. I just want to say that even if the hair of Raj Thackeray is touched, then entire Maharashtra will be on..." He claimed he has sought security cover for Thackeray and his family from the government but has received no response.
